- Verify Load Limits:** Remove excess cables or redistribute them across multiple trays to prevent overloading. Ensure the tray type matches the cable weight and volume.
- Secure Fasteners and Joints:** Tighten bolts, clamps, and connectors to prevent movement. Replace any damaged or corroded hardware.
- Use Correct Materials and Accessories:** For outdoor or corrosive environments, select galvanized or stainless steel trays. Consider dividers or cable organizers to reduce u...
