Distribution boxes should: Be installed in dry, accessible areas with proper ventilation and at a safe height (~1.5m) Use insulated bushings for cable entry to prevent accidental contact Include grounding and bonding to minimize voltage differences across the site Follow NEC, OSHA, and local codes for temporary wiring, including proper breaker sizing and conductor ampacity Labeling and Safety Each circuit should be clearly labeled inside the distribution box and on the exterior panel Use UL/CE-certified components and ensure all breakers, fuses, and surge protectors are properly rated Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests before energizing circuits Maintain a record of installation and color-coding for futur...
