Three-Level Distribution System

Primary Distribution Box: This is the main distribution point, typically connected directly to a transformer. It handles high-voltage input (e.g., 0.4kV from a transformer) and distributes power to secondary boxes. It usually contains isolating switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) but does not supply power directly to end-use equipment.

Secondary Distribution Box: Also called sub-distribution boxes, these serve specific areas such as buildings or floors. They handle three-phase power and are equipped with larger circuit breakers. Secondary boxes often feature inner and outer doors, powder-coated exteriors, and rainproof tops for outdoor use, forming part of a three-level protection system.

Tertiary Distribution Box: This is the final connection point for individual electrical appliances. Tertiary boxes can be fixed or movable and supply single-phase power (220V) to sockets. Each appliance is connected through a dedicated RCD, following the principle of "one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock," ensuring safety and preventing multiple devices from being controlled by a single switch.

Sockets and Safety Features

Sockets are integrated at the tertiary level to provide convenient access for electrical devices. Modern distribution boxes may include:

- Circuit breakers or RCBOs for overload and leakage protection.
- Power indicators and voltage/current displays for monitoring.
- Waterproof and shock-resistant designs for outdoor or industrial use.
- Plug-in connections for easier installation and maintenance compared to traditional terminal wiring.
