Calculate tray width and depth based on the number and type of cables, ensuring proper spacing to prevent overheating and allow future expansion.
- 4. Mounting and Support** Install supports, brackets, and hangers at recommended intervals (typically 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load). Align trays straight and level, connecting sections with appropriate fittings. For long runs, use cable tray rollers to prevent kinks and damage during cable laying.
- 5. Cable Laying and Organization** Lay cables neatly within the tray, using cable ties or straps to separate by voltage, function, or signal type. Maintain minimum bend radii at tray e...
