4. Insert the Connector Push the connector straight into the adapter or port until it clicks or locks in place. Avoid bending the fiber sharply; maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent damage.
5. Verify the Connection Use an OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) or a power meter to check signal integrity and ensure low insertion loss . Label the patch cord and port for future maintenance and troubleshooting.
