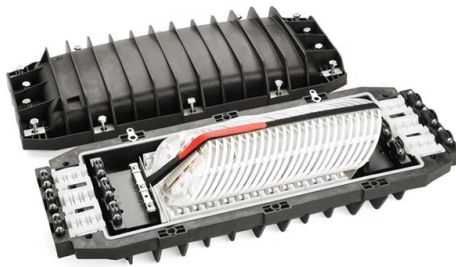

Unlike mechanical splicing (which simply holds fibers together), fusion splicing creates a continuous optical path that minimizes signal loss—making it the. Fusion splicing is used for joining cables during network installation projects, repairing cables, mounting pre-polished splice-on connectors, and many applications in factories that make fiber optic components and subsystems.
