

Switch Router Fiber Optic Connection Method

- Direct Fiber Connection:** If both the router and switch have SFP/SFP+ ports, insert compatible SFP modules into each device. Connect the devices using the appropriate fiber optic cable (single-mode or multi-mode). Ensure proper alignment and secure connections to prevent signal loss.

Step 4: Configure the Network

Access the router's admin panel to verify WAN connectivity and configure IP settings. For managed switches, configure VLANs, QoS, or link aggregation if needed to optimize performance. Test connectivity by pinging devices across the switch to ensure the fiber link is active.
