Additionally, duplex mode, negotiation settings, and port status should be verified to ensure the optical link comes up correctly. Troubleshooting Tips If the optical port does not activate after inserting a module: Verify the module is certified and matches the fiber type and interface speed. Check the port configuration and ensure it is enabled and set to optical mode if it is a combo port. Use diagnostic commands (e.g., `display transceiver` on Huawei or `show fiber-ports-optical-transceiver` on Cisco) to check optical power, temperature, and link status.
